## Transcripts

Baystate Continuing Education maintains a continuing education transcript for you under your unique CE ID number. Remember to use this unique ID number consistently, every time you register for a regional seminar or attend grand rounds.

To access your transcript, login to the continuing education portal with your CE ID number at our website [www.baystatehealth.org/learn](http://www.baystatehealth.org/learn) then click on the CE credits tab.

- Baystate Employees, your CE ID number is your EN number including the letters EN
- Baystate medical staff members login with your PN number, including the letters PN
- If you are a returning user but neither an employee nor a member of the medical staff, your CE ID number is the first letter of your first name; mm/dd (month and day you were born, no year) and the last four digits of your social security number

The CE credits tab includes the Baystate courses you have attended since 2009.

- To check the courses you are currently registered for, click the current schedule tab
- The history tab includes the courses you have attended and the amount paid.
