DIRECTIONS

From the Massachusetts Turnpike East or West:

Take exit 4 (West Springfield); then follow the signs to I-91 North towards Holyoke. Take Exit 15-Lower Westfield Road/Ingleside. Turn left off the exit ramp. Go about 0.2 mile to the second set of lights and left onto Homestead Avenue/Whitney Avenue. Go 0.2 mile. The entrance to the Baystate Health Education Center will be on the right.

From Connecticut and Points South:

Take I-91 North towards Holyoke. Take Exit 15-Lower Westfield Road/Ingleside. Turn left off the exit ramp. Go about 0.2 mile to the second set of lights and left onto Homestead Avenue/Whitney Avenue. Go 0.2 mile. The entrance to the Baystate Health Education Center will be on the right.

From Vermont and Points North:

Take I-91 South to Exit 15 (Lower Westfield Road/Ingleside). Turn right off the exit ramp. Turn left at the lights onto Homestead Avenue /Whitney Avenue. Continue 0.2 miles on Whitney Avenue. The Baystate Health Education Center will be on the right.

There is free surface parking. Park in the upper half of the parking lot which is nearest the Education Center. Enter through the glass foyer.
