Rays of Hope – A Walk Toward the Cure of Breast Cancer steps off on Sunday, October 25, 2009

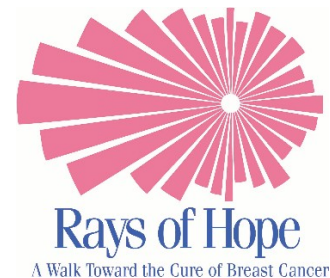
- **Create a School Team!** School Teams can be broken down into smaller teams such as “Class of..”, sports teams, swim team, teachers team, and more!
